PROGRAM TYPES

•Traditional University Immersion

- Study at a local university with your local students and other UC peers.

•UCLA Faculty-Led

- Experiential courses “on-the-go” with UCLA professors over the summer

•Intern/Research Abroad

- Intern or research abroad for credit!

•UC Center Programs

- Courses abroad exclusively with UC peers



Dozen Other Types Too!



PROGRAM TYPES

- **Most programs are not designed around specific majors.**
- **Not obligated to “study abroad in their major!”**
 - GEs, minor, foreign language, technical breadth (if applicable), units, personal or professional development.
 - Still makes progress toward degree.
- **Expand your search beyond “major-related programs!”**

UCLA IEO Programs

UCLA TRAVEL STUDY

- Terms:** Summer
- Format:** 3-5 week experiential learning programs led by UCLA faculty.
UCLA courses; no need to petition for credit
- Best For:**
 - Automatic GEs, Foreign Language, Diversity, Writing II
 - Major/Minor requirements, if participating department



UCLA Travel Study - Sample Programs

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN

- **Location:** Copenhagen, Denmark
- **Timeframe:** Summer, 4 weeks
- **Highlights:** Student residences, shared facilities, self-catered, several programmed excursions.
- **Coursework:**
 - SCAND 50W: Intro to Scandinavian Literature and Culture
 - SCAND 143C: Scandinavian Crime Literature
 - SCAND 199: Directed Research - optional
- **Satisfies:**
 - Diversity*, Writing II, Literary and Cultural Analysis GE

UCLA IEO Programs

UCLA GLOBAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

- **Terms:** Summer
- **Format:** Intern abroad and online class for UCLA credit!
- **Best For:**
 - Majors & Minors – Education, Economics, Engineering (all), Global Studies, Global Health, International and Area Studies, International and Development Studies, Political Science, & Public Affairs
 - Most open to all students!



UCLA Global Internship - Sample Programs



POLITICAL SCIENCE TRACK

- **Location:** Bogota, Medellin, Buenos Aires, Cape Town, Dublin, Prague, or Virtual
- **Timeframe:** Summer, 8 weeks
- **Highlights:** Internship abroad with an advocacy group, finance sector, NGO, etc., student residences with other interns and students, excursions
- **Coursework:**
 - POL SCI 195CE: Internship Course (required)
 - CESC 130: Intercultural Communication in the Global Workplace

UCLA EDUCATION ABROAD PROGRAM (UCEAP)

- Terms:** Summer, Fall, Winter, Spring, Year
- Format:** Traditional university immersion, international summer, research, field work, intern, UC center, and more!
- Best For:**
 - Program Options

UCEAP - Sample Programs

YONSEI UNIVERSITY SUMMER

- **Location:** Seoul, South Korea
- **Timeframe:** Summer
- **Highlights:** Short-term summer program; courses in English with other international student, Korean language optional, pre-arranged dorms.
- **Sample Coursework:**
 - Korean Language (Beginner – Advanced)
 - Korean Cinema
 - Introduction to Art History
 - Asian American Literature



UCEAP - Sample Programs

UNIVERSITY OF GLASGOW

- **Location:** Glasgow, Scotland
- **Timeframe:** Fall, Spring, Year
- **Highlights:** Courses taught in English at host university with local students, apartments or dorms, self-catered.
- **Sample Coursework:**
 - Advanced Design and Directing Courses
 - Film & Video in Theater & Performance
 - Writing for Performance
 - Queer Theory in Theater
 - Documentary Drama
 - Scotland Film & Television




UCEAP - Sample Programs

UNIVERSITY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

- **Location:** Vancouver, Canada
- **Timeframe:** Fall, Spring, Year
- **Highlights:** Courses taught in English at host university with local students, not *too* far from home, apartments/dorms
- **Sample Coursework:**
 - Acting Various – Intro Through Advanced
 - Design & Construction (Costume, Scenery, etc.)
 - Women in Theatre and Film
 - Technical Production
 - Screenwriting
 - Canadian Cinema

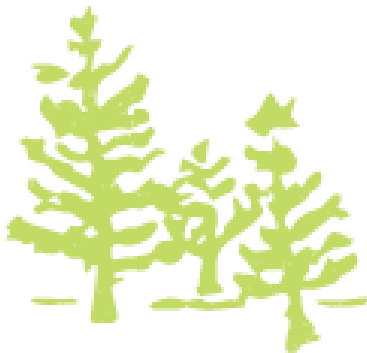

Program Types



NON-UC PROGRAMS

- Terms:** Various
- Format:**
 - No guarantee of credit *transferring* to UCLA.
 - No UCLA financial aid; can still apply to external scholarships
 - Planned Academic Leave (PAL)
- Best For:**
 - Students who do not depend on UCLA financial aid and cannot find the right program within the UC offerings

TIP: UCLA QUARTERS VS. TERMS ABROAD

- A handful of programs do not align with this. Always verify program dates!
- A few quarter-only abroad options exist:
 - Fall Quarter
 - Winter Quarter
 - Spring Quarter

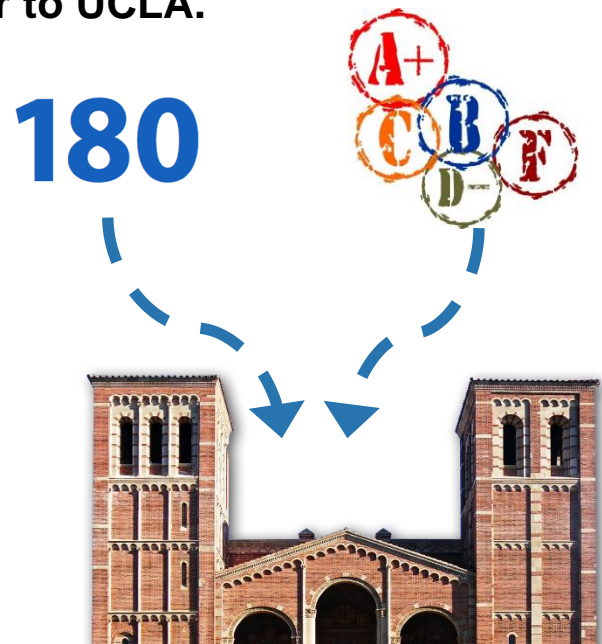
TIP: TRANSFERRING ≠ SATISFYING REQUIREMENTS

- **All UC programs discussed guarantee courses transfer to UCLA.**

- UCLA TS, UCLA GIP, and UCEAP
- Non-UC programs – no transfer guaranteed

- **Petitioning for degree requirements.**

- Major/Minor = respective department
- GEs, Foreign Language, Diversity, Writing II = college/school

UCLA Study Abroad

CAN I USE MY UCLA FINANCIAL AID FOR A STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM?

- Eligible students can use UCLA Financial Aid to cover the costs of UC-affiliated study abroad programs.
- Could be comprised of grants, loans, and scholarships.
- Generally must take a minimum of 8 units.
- Complete FAFSA/DREAM Act by priority deadline!



Program Costs and Funding



SCHOLARSHIPS

- Need, identity, and merit-based scholarships are available!
- Sample Opportunities
 - UCLA Scholarships (\$1,000 - \$5,000+)
 - UCEAP and UCLA Travel Study Scholarships (\$1,000 - \$8,000)
 - External Scholarships
 - Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarships (\$2,500 - \$8,000)
 - Diversity Abroad Scholarships (\$1,000)
 - Many more!
- Many have deadlines months in advance – plan ahead!

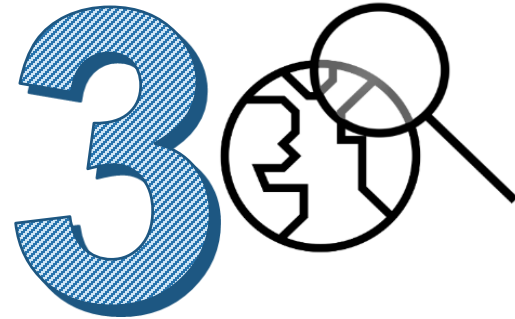

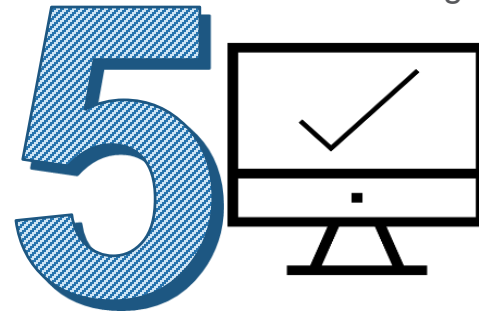

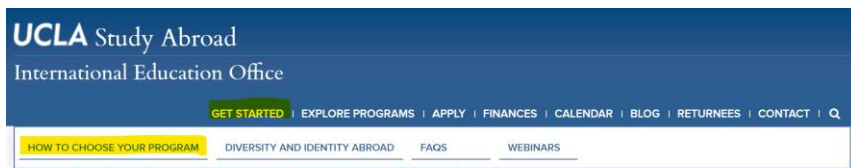
