- At least 20 units must be applied exclusively to the Theater minor and not shared with any other major or minor program.
- ONLY courses on this list are approved to complete Theater minor requirements. No petitions for substitutions will be approved.
- All courses for the minor must be taken in residence at UCLA. No petitions of substitute coursework will be approved. Theater minor courses taken in UCLA Summer Session are eligible. UCLA Extension and study abroad courses are not approved. Transfer credit for any of the above is subject to department approval.
- Applications will ONLY be accepted in Week One of each quarter, each year. Summer applications are accepted by petition - ([Student \(Blue\) Petition](#))
